The **Animation C.C.C. (DMAC)** degree is a collegiate degree program consisting of lower-division courses where students learn how to bring their artwork, characters, and stories to life. Students learn to convert their artistic abilities in to digital animation skills using the latest industry-standard software. Students will have the opportunity to develop and create an original animated story.

After completing this program, students will have a strong knowledge of the skills and equipment needed to create digital animation sequences, enabling them to make an informed choice about their future education and career path.

This college credit certificate can be completed as part of the **Digital Media and Design, A.S.** program. To do this, the student must take **DIG 2302C** and **DIG 2430C** as electives in the A.S. program.

Note: Digital Media courses that are only offered in the fall semester are designated as "fall only." Digital Media courses that are only offered in the spring semester are designated as "spring only."
