PRE-ENROLLMENT ACTION ITEMS

1. Apply for Admission: Click the following link to apply. <u>https://apply.fgc.edu/Ellucian.ERecruiting.Web.External/page</u> <u>s/welcome.aspx</u> Fill in the required term. "COSM" is the program code.

- 2. Apply for financial aid. Apply online at https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa
- Take required proof of residency (see page four of application) to admissions in building 15, at Florida Gateway College's Main Campus. Or email documents to: <u>enrollment.services@fgc.edu</u>
- 4. Have official high school and all college transcripts sent to the FGC admissions office.

- Schedule and take the TABE Test, if not exempt. This can be taken in the FGC testing center. To schedule a TABE test go to this website._ <u>https://www2.registerblast.com/fgc/exam/list.</u> The test is free for FGC students.
- 6. Complete the Cosmetology Application Booklet found on the college website <u>Cosmetology Application and submit the booklet to the program coordinator</u>.
