- Tourniquet Applications – Airway management – Gunshot – Wound and Mult-Trauma care – Care under fire – one-handed shooting techniques and malfunction drills – and much more.
- Students will bring assigned duty gear, 250 rounds of handgun ammo and 250 rounds of rifle ammo, eye and ear protection, and range attire. **** LEAD FREE AMMO*****
